Hedges and Hedgerows what you need to know.

The Council has brought up the issue of overhanging branches, uncontrolled hedges and hedge rows in last months Issue.

I thought it would be good to get some pointers from the relevant websites and remind us all of our duty of care in relation to our hedges. And the people around us.

What is a hedge:

A Hedge is a barrier formed wholly or predominantly by a line of 2 or more evergreen or semi-evergreen trees or shrubs. (Bamboo and Ivy are not included).

Hedges can be used as an environmental friendly way to create a barrier whilst enriching the environment for our garden friends. They are often rich in fruits/ berries, provide fantastic nesting sites and protect the birds from extreme weather and predators.

Neighbour disputes :

Height;

Although there is no legal set height for hedges any hedge that is over 2 meters of height can fall under the Anti Social Behaviour act 2003/ amended 2008.

The High hedges Act can be called upon when you can not amicably agree with your neighbour on an acceptable height.

The council will take into consideration loss of (day) light.

However before you go to the council it would be best if you could come to some agreement , after all you have to live next to each other.

Width:

You do not need permission from the hedge owner to take off any branches that are overhanging your boundary however you do need to ask them if they want to trim the hedge themselves first. Any offcuts should be offered back to it's rightful owner, at the same time you cannot just dispose of the offcuts onto your neighbour's property.

No hedge should be trimmed between 1st March and 31st August.

(Although some exceptions apply see: www.gov.uk).

Roots:

If Roots are at the problem, you are entitled to cut those back to the boundary too.

Should the roots cause damage to your property it is a case for the insurance. This also applies to individual trees and there are clear specifications on how far away from the neighbour boundary you are to plant a tree based on the root span.

(Note: should you damage the tree or hedge due to cutting back roots or branches you can be held liable for any damage it causes should it fall over)

Highways and footpaths:

If footpaths or bridle paths are obstructed by hedges or trees, either by overhanging branches, or sticking out roots a complaint can be lodged with your local councillor.

If hedges are being allowed to get too high and thus obstructing the view for traffic or causing damage or danger to vehicles, pedestrians or horse riders the same rules apply.

The council can apply to the owner to cut back their trees and hedges within a time frame, should the owner refuse or neglect the request than the council can instruct to have the work done and recover any cost from the tree/hedge owner.





Tadmarton Charities

As in the past I thought it would be helpful to give a little background to the charity especially for new people to the village

Tadmarton Charities is an amalgamation of the Poor's Land Charity, the Macdermot Charity and the Macdermot's Educational Charity. The Poor's Land Charity arose from the Inclosures Act of 1775 when a small area of land, which is now part of Tadmarton Golf Course, was made available to help the poor and needy of the parish. Subsequently this land was swapped for the 16 acres which the charities now own. This comprises of 2 fields which run down from the golf course road and up to a field owned by the Banbury Ornithological Society.

The 16 acres of land provide a rental income which makes up the majority of the income distributed to recipients in the parish. The other main investment is a holding in M & G Charifund originally of £12,500 which were monies received for granting a right of access to the Banbury Ornithological Society land back in 2005. This holding does not distribute income and with the addition of £3,000 from our Building Society account was worth £28,823 at the date of the last accounts (Dec 2018). We have in the last few years withdrawn £3,000 to help top up the recent distributions.

The Trustees are strictly bound by the trust deed which allows us to '**relieve either generally, or individually, those residents of the Parish who are considered to be in genuine need, or suffering hardship, or distress**'. It is interesting to look back and see that in 1867 the charity delivered coal to 70 families who were deemed to qualify.

However there are still people and families who are in genuine need and it is the trustees job to allocate funds to them.

They do of course rely on people applying for themselves or nominating others.

The Trustees would now like to hear from any person who feels that they, a neighbour, friend, or family member, might qualify for consideration for the 2019 distribution.

The name, address and brief details should be provided to the Clerk to the Trustees at the address given below. Those who have always received help from the Charity will automatically be considered and need not reapply.

"Ahoy there!" from Sibford Gower Endowed Primary School

Our younger children started the new academic year with an exciting learning project linked to the theme of 'Land Ahoy!'

At the beginning of the project, Acorn & Beech Classes travelled all the way to Stratford upon Avon to spend the morning out on the water, cruising up and down the River Avon and experiencing what it is like to be afloat. For some of the children, this was the first time they had been on a boat

and it was all very exciting! They also went to and fro on the chain ferry and all returned to school feeling like experienced sailors. One of the children said, "I've never been on a boat before and now I've been on two!"

This special trip marked the start of a half-term's work in which the children became immersed in work exploring the theme of a life on the sea. As scientists, they explored how it is that boats float. They learned about historical sea-faring explorers such as Captain Cook and learned about the points of the compass and how these are used to create maps. They explored maps of the world, identifying different seas and oceans, and made their own maps. The children created some wonderful art work and helped to turn their library area into a maritime museum, complete with sailing boat, fishing nets and a lobster pot.

Pirate Day was great fun, with pupils and adults arriving at school in swashbuckling pirate costumes. Each of the children was given their own pirate name and they practised speaking like pirates. During this day, the children developed their design technology skills; they made origami boats, painted class pirate flags, labelled parts of ships, made treasure maps and split-pin pirates, and worked collaboratively using a range of materials to make their own boats.

Towards the end of the term, Beech Class invited their parents and carers in for a special assembly to share some of their learning. Our visitors were treated to a really delightful celebration of learning, including a rousing musical performance during which the children sang sea-shanties and played some tuned instruments and their own school-made instruments to lead us through the story of a hunt for pirate treasure.

When asked what they had enjoyed most about this topic, Tristan said "Everything!"

Well, shiver me timbers! What a great start to the school year!






